

MATHEMATICS RAFT WRITING

RAFT writing allows students to write so that they can learn. You learn through use of a writing prompt that has learners think about a concept or topic through different perspectives (Santa, 1989)

The *RAFT* Framework Includes:

- **ROLE** of the Writer (Who are you as the writer?)
- **AUDIENCE** (To whom are you writing?)
- **FORMAT** (What format are you writing?)
- **TOPIC** (What are you writing about?)
